EVENT AT DREAMLAND MARGATE

Dreamland Margate are hosting the annual Screamlend event during the month of October 2018 on the following dates; 13th, 19th, 20th, 25th, 26th, 27th and 31st October 2018.

This letter explains what Dreamland are doing to minimise the effect on you as a resident, and how to get in touch if you have any concerns.

TRAFFIC

In order to ensure that the large number of people attending the events can enter the concourse safely at the start of each day, the event requires the road directly outside its main pedestrian entrance to be managed for the queuing and the daily ingress periods.

As a result, Hall By The Sea Road may be temporarily closed to traffic between approximately 17:00 and 21:00 daily on the 13th, the 19th & 20th, 25th, 26th and 27th and the 31st October.

EVENT SITE

Dreamland Margate will ensure that local public spaces affected by the uplift in footfall are clean and returned to the best possible standard post event.

The event is being held across all areas of Dreamland Margate and preparation is well underway. It is not expected to impact local residents or businesses.

Residents and seafront businesses access will be maintained but may be delayed while traffic engineers ensure the safety of attendees.

IMPACT OF THE EVENT

Dreamland Margate have worked extensively to ensure that the impact of the event on residents is minimised.

During the event Dreamland Margate staff will aim to respond quickly and effectively to issues raised by residents.
